Customers subscribe to a portion of a community solar project. Your subscription is meant to offset 80% of your annual electricity usage.





Your subscription will generate a certain amount of electricity each month. All electricity produced by the community solar project goes straight to the utility grid.





You'll receive a Bill Credit on your utility bill each month that is proportionate to the electricity that your subscription produced.





You pay a Subscription Fee for your Bill Credit. Your Subscription Fee will always be less than the value of your credit, saving you money.

# What is the Oregon Community Solar Program?

The Oregon Community Solar Program gives customers of Portland General Electric, Pacific Power and Idaho Power new opportunities to go solar without needing to own a home, have a sunny roof, or make upfront investments. Customers can subscribe to a community solar project and receive a credit on their monthly utility bill for the electricity from their portion of the project. There is a monthly fee, but it will always be less than the value of your credit, saving you money.

Community Solar is a wonderful alternative to onsite solar that gives you access to the benefits of solar without the hassle and cost of installing solar onsite. It's easy and free to sign up!

## Income Qualified Subscribers

# How do I know if I'm income qualified?

Low-income qualified participants save 40% on their subscribed electricity. You must be a qualifying utility customer and have a gross income at or below 80% state median income. Check the income chart to verify eligibility.

If you qualify based on the income chart above, the next steps are to schedule an intake appointment with Community Energy Project (CEP). This is so that CEP can verify your income and collect any necessary information in order to get your subscription sized.
