

Neighborhood Assns and organizations tell public officials: Protect our region from CEI Hub risks



CEI Hub:

- Lies within Portland city limits
- Sits on the banks of Willamette River, along Hwy 30
- Stores toxic chemicals & more than 90% of Oregon's liquid fuel
- Emits toxic releases & pollution
- Is at risk of storage tank failure, train derailments, fire
- Is built on unstable, liquefiable soils in a predicted earthquake zone "...estimates of fuel releases...are the same magnitude as...the Deep-Water Horizon spill of 2010 – the largest oil spill in US waters to date." City-County CEI Hub Seismic Analysis, 2022
- Will greatly intensify the effects of an earthquake, causing our economy to grind to a halt.
- Reminds us "the best way to deal with an emergency is to prevent it," Chris Voss director, Multnomah County emergency mgmt.
